

# GLACIER BROADBAND INTERNET PROJECT PLEDGE FORM

We have been presented with an opportunity to bring broadband service to Glacier. Northwest Open Access Network (NoaNet) has received Federal Stimulus Funding grants to create a fiber-optic broadband network for underserved and un-served rural communities in rural Washington State. They will be bringing open access fiber from the Whatcom County Parks Department building, on Smith Road and the Mt. Baker Highway, up to Kendall and the new Resource Center to be built in Kendall. They are very likely to have additional funds, which they can use on a discretionary basis. NoaNet is interested in using any unspent funds to extend service to Glacier. To do this, they will need us to provide the 30% match that is required by the grant. NoaNet estimates that the total cost for this final leg will be \$750,000.00. The Glacier area communities will need to provide \$230,000.00 and document a sufficient customer base and revenue stream to support the system. Donations will be needed in order to provide the matching funds.
